The KCE curriculum program will commence on **1 September 2025** and conclude in **July 2026**.

Attendance in person is mandatory for all classes; virtual attendance is not permitted.

Only shortlisted applicants will be contacted for the next steps in the selection process. If you do not hear from us, please understand that you have not been shortlisted.
